How will I know how well my child is doing?

Please find below a summary of ways we celebrate your child's success at North Lancing School:

House Points

Your child will be in one of four houses - Dragon, Pegasus, Phoenix or Unicorn. They will earn house points for good work, progress, effort and exemplary behaviour. These house points are added together weekly and the results given in the Friday Award assembly and the newsletter.

Merit Certificates/Badges

During the award assembly your child may be given a merit. In Reception to Year 2 this will be a certificate and a badge (the colour of their house). Years 3-6 receive a badge. The certificate will state how your child has been successful. These are awarded for consistent hard work or good behaviour over the week, a particularly good piece of work and excellent progress. Approximately four children per class receive a merit each week.

Teacher Feedback

You may receive a note, home/school book comment or a telephone call from your child's class teacher from time to time. These will let you know about good progress, behaviour or work.

Head Teacher Award

Your child may receive a Head Teacher award. This consists of a certificate celebrating the reason your child has been given the award, a sticker and a mention in the weekly newsletter. Head teacher awards are given for exceptional work, consistent hard work and effort over a period of time or significant progress.

Parents Consultations

You will have three formal opportunities a year to meet with your child's class teacher, one in the Autumn term, one in Spring and follow up to school reports in the Summer. You can sign up for a time at the school reception office or by phone anytime in the week before these dates. You will be able to discuss your child's learning and achievement, areas for your child to develop further and ideas for helping your child at home.

Annual School Report

In July each year you will receive a school report summarizing your child's learning, progress, effort and achievement over the course of the year. A section is included on your child's personal and social development. The report will also set out targets for the following year. You will be given an opportunity to comment on your child's progress for the year.

Handwriting Heroes

A handwriting certificate will be awarded to one student from each class who has demonstrated either most improved handwriting or particularly neat, careful writing. Their work will also be displayed in the hall for a week. The best/or most improved overall handwriting for the week will also win a pencil (lower school) or a pen (upper school).



Attendance Award

Your child may bring home an attendance award certificate. These are given termly to children with a 100% attendance record. A special certificate will awarded to any children who have 100% attendance at the end of the school year.

Swimming Certificate

Your child may bring home a swimming certificate. These are graded, the first level being starfish, followed by the stingray, otter, shark and dolphin successively. Your child should wear a yellow hat until receiving their stingray certificate as this helps the teacher quickly identify who can swim independently. On receiving their stingray certificate your child can wear a white hat.

Sports Certificates

Our school sports teams often compete against other local school teams. Children often receive certificates for competing and/or winning various tournaments throughout the year.

External Achievements

We also like to share in your child's success outside of school. If they receive certificates, trophies or awards outside of school e.g. for football, swimming, or piano, these can be brought into school and given out during the Friday award assembly.
