The home-school reading record explained

The home-school book has been amended to provide more detailed information on your child's reading. The left hand page is the 'home' page and is to be used by you to record any reading or reading related activities you do with your child. Your child expected to read daily. It would be appreciated if you could sign the book weekly in the space provided.

The right hand page is the school page. The new layout is explained below:

On some occasions there may not be a next step or word to learn - in this instance you can recap any that have been given previously.
